





Consumption: Past 30 days: Overall










Percent of 10th graders reporting "yes" to the following in the past 30 days








Percent of 11th graders reporting "yes" to the following in the past 30 days









Tobacco product use and sources: Past 30 days


Sources of obtaining tobacco products



How old were you the first time you smoked all or part of a cigarette?










Alcohol: Number of drinks and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol

On the days you drink alcohol, about how many drinks do you have on average?



During the past year, how many times did you drive a car or other vehicle while you were under the influence of alcohol?







Out of every 20 students your age, how many do you think have used MARIJUANA at least once in the past 30 days?




Out of every 20 students your age, how many do you think have used SYNTHETIC MARIJUANA at least once in the past 30 days?


